Case: Skeletonized stainless steel

Middle Case: Stainless steel + Black IP coating

Bezel: Fixed stainless steel bezel with IP Black and silver stainless steel insert with tachymeter

Case Back: Stainless steel

Water Resistance: 100 meters

Case Size: 40mm

Lug Width: 20mm

Crystal: Double-curved sapphire crystal with triple-layer anti-reflective coating

Crown: Screw-down crown in stainless steel

Dial: Black guilloché with silver printing, silver counters with black and silver printing

Hands: High-polished silver

Movement: Swiss Made Ronda 5021D

- Chronograph Movement with date Window
- 10 jewels/gilt
- Battery-life: 54 months

Bracelet: Stainless steel with custom-designed stainless steel deployant buckle

Bracelet Adjustment: Self-adjustable removable links featuring effortless bracelet size adjustment without the need for tools

Strap: NBR (synthetic rubber) with custom designed stainless steel deployant buckle

Timex Atelier Chronograph Quartz M1q: Setting the Time & Chronograph Functions

Setting the Time:

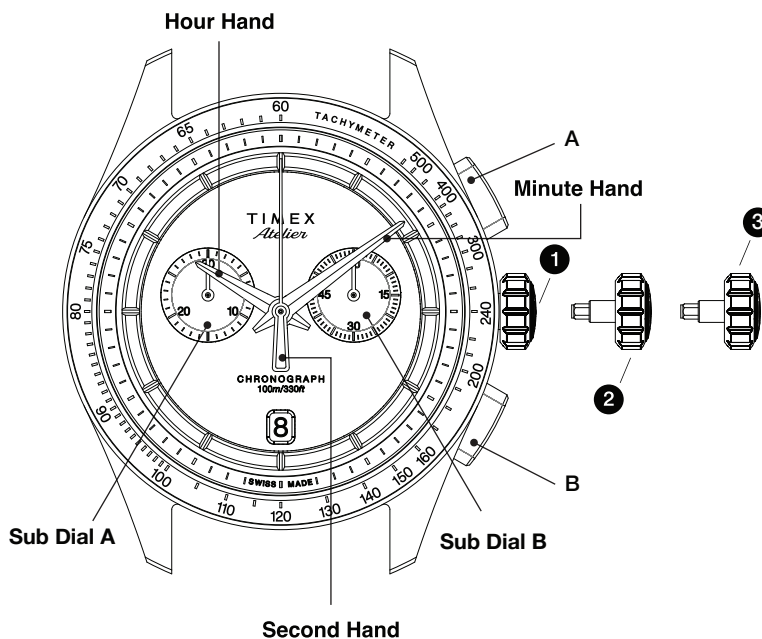
Pull out the Crown to position 3
Turn until the desired time is reached, return the Crown to position 1

Setting the Date:

Pull out the Crown to position 2
Turn until the desired date is reached, return the Crown to position 1

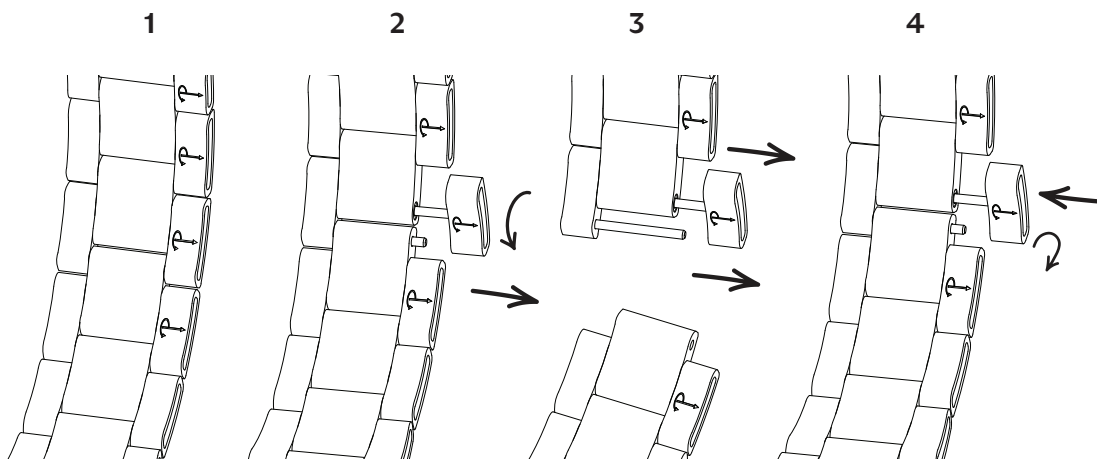
Chronograph Pushers & Sub Dials:

Pusher A: Start/Stop (2 o'clock)
Pusher B: Reset (4 o'clock)
Sub Dial A Hand 30 minutes
Sub Dial B Hand 60 seconds



Resize the Bracelet with Self-Adjustable Links

- 1 Select adjustable links with the symbol 
- 2 Pull out and rotate the adjustable links with the symbol  to open
- 3 Remove the desired number of adjustable links
- 4 Pull out and rotate again to close and secure the bracelet.
